

Traveling While Black is a **360° cinematic virtual reality experience** that immerses viewers in the long history of restricted movement for Black Americans and the creation of safe spaces in our communities.

This film by Academy Award winner Roger Ross Williams and Emmy Award-winning Felix & Paul Studios transports viewers to the historic Green Book site - Ben's Chili Bowl.

While seated at the Ware Center in an installation replicating this diner, viewers will don Oculus Go virtual reality headsets to share an intimate series of moments with several of Ben's patrons, as they reflect on their personal experiences regarding race relations in the United States.

Confronting the way we understand and talk about race in America, *Traveling While Black* highlights the urgent need to not only remember the past but to learn from it, and to encourage conversation and thought about the challenges minorities still face today.
